## OAK BROOK

The main entrance is on Spring Road 0.5 mile south of 31st Street and 0.5 mile north of York Road. Parking is also available at the intersection of York and Spring roads.

## PLEASE BE AWARE

- Horses allowed on Night Heron Trail only

## PRESERVE FEATURES

- Oak woodlands and Salt Creek habitat — beavers, red foxes, herons, egrets, migratory birds, songbirds, wildflowers
- Civilian Conservation Corps-constructed bridges and visitor center
- Fullersburg Woods Nature Education Center open daily 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. except select holidays
- Graue Mill and Museum, Graue House and Fuller House
- Picturesque view of Salt Creek from benches in southern section of preserve
- Access to fishing spots along Salt Creek
