

# Frequently Asked Questions

**Hello Campers!! We are excited to have you out for the unique camping experience of Snores & S'mores.**

## **What time should we arrive?**

We will start the check-in at 4 p.m. to allow you time to setup your tent on the baseball field. We just ask that you do not head to the event area until 5 p.m. to allow staff time to finish setting up the event.

## **Where do we check in?**

You will be checked in at the entrance of the park while you are in your vehicle. At that time, you will need to fill out a waiver and all participants will be given a wristband to indicate that you are with the event. We ask that you wear the wristband during the duration of the event.

## **Where do we park?**

The park is closed to the public after 3 p.m. and all parking should be available on-site at the park.

## **What camping gear do we need to bring?**

You will need a tent, sleeping bag, and pillow. We also recommend a flashlight, extra snacks, and extra water for the night. There are no electrical outlets for air mattress blowers. It can get cold in the night and there is a heavy dew in the morning. Things left outside (including you) can get wet.

## **What food will be served for dinner?**

We will be serving hot dogs, hamburgers, (veggie patties on request), baked beans (vegetarian on request), coleslaw, and chips from 6 p.m. until 7:30 p.m.

At 8:15 p.m. we will have popcorn and s'mores available. Water and lemonade will be served throughout duration of the event.

## **What activities will there be?**

Once you set up your tent (but not earlier than 5 p.m.), head to the open space just to the east of the baseball field. There are ongoing activities including crafts, inflatables, BINGO, relays, face painting, and games. Activities are from 5 - 8 p.m. An outdoor movie presentation will start at 8:15 p.m.

## **Do I need money for anything?**

All activities are included in the price of admission. No money is necessary at the event.

## **What time is 'lights out'?**

As a courtesy to our neighbors, we ask that there be no talking or excessive loud noises after 11 p.m. If you find the need to leave during the night, you are welcome to come back in the morning. There will be a security guard on-site patrolling the area from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. If you encounter a problem in the night, please inform the security guard.

## **What food will be served for breakfast?**

We will be serving a continental breakfast with bananas, grapes, mini muffins, mini bagels, Gogurt, coffee, hot chocolate, orange juice and apple juice.

## **What time does the event end?**

The event ends at 9 a.m. All camping equipment has to be off of the baseball field by 10 a.m. for other scheduled programs.

## **Who do I contact for 'Lost and Found'?**

If you lose an item during the event, it will be taken to the information booth. All lost and found items after the event will be taken back to the special events office. You can contact 760-602-7519.
