COVID-19 Basketball Camp Protocol

This guidance applies basketball camp sessions hosted by the Claremont Parks & Rec. Dept. in Claremont, NH. Below is a list of the most important protocols and changes due to COVID-19.

**All policies & procedures can be found in the Stay at Home 2.0 Reopening Guidance at NH.GOV.*

1. Instructors, participants, and parents/guardians are strongly encouraged to wear reusable/washable cloth face coverings as much as possible, especially to and from each session.
2. Sessions must be non-contact with a focus on skills and drills.
3. Instructors and all participants will sanitize hands before and after sessions. Sanitizer will be available on site for use.
4. 6 ft social distancing protocols for instructors, participants and spectators will be used throughout each session and will always be monitored by the instructor.
5. Instructors will be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 using a series of 5 questions. Everyone must be able to answer NO to all 5 questions to begin the session. (If you have a cough or show any signs/symptoms of being sick STAY HOME PLEASE!)
6. Each participant should bring their own equipment (I.E. basketball) if possible. All equipment used that is returned to the instructor will be properly disinfected after each session.
7. Water fountains will be closed, so each child should come with their own water for the session.
8. Bathroom facilities will be open during each session.
9. An isolation room has been established at the Claremont Savings Bank Community Center in the event a participant or instructor begins to show signs of COVID-19. If this occurs, the parent/guardian will be notified immediately and the individual will need to be picked up. Furthermore, there is a strict course of action in place pertaining to confirmed cases of COVID-19 that could arise. (See NH.GOV for all the details)
