## REGISTRATION:

\*Registration: July 1st until July 31st

\*Register online at [www.concordparksandrec.org](http://www.concordparksandrec.org) or come by one of the three Recreation centers (Academy, Hartsell, and Logan) between 8am to 5pm Mon—Fri

\*Register in person on Saturday, July 27, 2019 at Academy Sports, 2211 Elder Lane, Kannapolis 28083 from 11:00am—2:00pm (Check or Cash only)

## COST:

\$35 per child for City of Concord Residents (includes jersey and hat/visor)

\$55 per child for Non-City Residents (includes jersey and hat/visor)

AGE DIVISIONS: (Divisions based on current age on or before May 1, 2019 for baseball, and June 1, 2019 for softball)

5 - 6 yr old Co-ed Baseball

7 - 8 yr old Baseball and Softball

9 - 10 yr old Baseball and Softball

11 - 12 yr old Baseball and Softball

13 -15 yr old Baseball and Softball

## SKILLS ASSESSMENTS: 7&8 Age Group and up

Location: Hartsell Park (60 Hartsell School Road)

Saturday, August 3 (9am-11am)

OR

Tuesday, August 6 (6pm-8pm)

(You can come to any one of two above days and expect to be there for 30 to 45 min)

Your child will be required to come to an assessment if they fall in one of the categories below:

- \*If your child is new to the Concord Parks and Rec Fall Baseball/Softball program
- \*If your child is moving up an age division from last year
- \*If your child's team is not returning from last year

If you do not receive communication from a Parks & Rec Athletic Staff member then you are required to be at one of the above two days. If your child does not show for skills assessments, then your child will be picked at random in the coaches draft.
