Below are the expectations of a Dublin Dance Centre & Gymnastics student performing company member. Please keep a copy of these expectations for your reference. If you have any questions, contact the director of the company.

By initialing the lines superseding each policy below, I understand and agree to abide by the statements as written. I further understand the rules/requirements noted in the Placement Program Policy Packet are pertinent to placement level students and company members.

NOTE: EACH PERFORMANCE COMPANY HAS UNIQUE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY. PLEASE REFER TO THE COMPANY ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS SHEET.

ATTENDANCE POLICIES:

___ I will maintain 80% attendance (75% summer and non-placement) in ALL technique classes and company classes (including conditioning).

_____An attendance update will be communicated to the company director if I am at less than 80% in any of my technique classes. If I am at risk in my technique classes, I am also at risk for losing eligibility in the company unless a make-up plan is established in my technique classes. We do ask that you manage and take responsibility for your make up records.

_____ I understand any school related activity such as cheerleading, track, volleyball, etc. may NOT interfere with company class if it takes me below the 80% company attendance mark. Any school related activity is permissible in placement classes required for one season (6-8 weeks) out of the year as long as comparable classes are being done in conjunction with the school activity season. I will talk to my teachers and director/s prior to making a seasonal commitment and will have a plan in place for comparable classes.

_____ Any absence (outside of holidays) during the four weeks prior to all performances will be pre-approved by the company director/s. This includes Halloween, Nutcracker, Spring, & June Performances where applicable. Failure to attend these four weeks could result in loss of performance privileges.

____ I understand all company members are encouraged to perform at parades, school day-out and community events. If unable to participate in any event/s I will immediately inform my company director & explain the absence.

_____ I understand the importance of the start time of rehearsal/class and will be properly prepared and in the studio on time. Upon arrival, I will begin limbering in the studio to prepare my body for the day. I understand this not only takes care of my body but also shows my readiness and demonstrates respect for my teachers and choreographers as well.

<u>Make-up classes are not available for company time.</u> Company directors and choreographers reserve the right to set pieces using the company members who are present which may eliminate participation for those company members that are absent. Company members who have missed choreography are expected to learn missed material themselves by understudying or from another company member.

____ I have read and understand what absences are considered excused as noted in section 3 of the Placement Program Policy Packet.

ILLNESS AND INJURY POLICIES:

____ I understand if I become ill or injured for an extended amount of time I will inform the company director/s immediately.

_____ If an extended illness or injury takes me below the 80% attendance policy, I will present a doctor's excuse/note to the company director/s and those classes will be made up when I am back in dancing/gymnastics condition.

If I have sustained an extended illness or injury that allows me to sit in class and watch, I will be present to do so.

_____ If I have sustained an extended illness or injury that allows me to do class on the floor, I will do so in order to keep my agility, strength and flexibility in order. Due to safety reasons I will not be allowed to dance half way through the class as I have missed my proper warm-up period.

DEMEANOR/CONDUCT AND COMMUNICATION POLICIES:

_____ I understand timeliness to all company related functions is a priority. If a "call" time or arrival time says 8:00 am, it means 8:00 am. Failure to be on time may result in a loss of performing privileges.

____ I understand being a company member is a privilege, and company members will demonstrate good demeanor both in and out of the classroom. The company member is considered to be a mentor to younger generations of dancers. I will set a good example at all times.

____ I understand if my conduct does not represent the company appropriately (for example, disrespect, bullying, etc.) I may lose performing privileges, and possibly be asked to withdraw from the company.

____ I understand all communication between company members and company directors will be through email and/or group text *(when applicable)*. I should look for and respond to all company emails and/or group texts *(when applicable)* in a timely manner.

INTENSIVE AND PRE-PRO BALLET COMPANY MEMBERS ONLY:

_____ I understand it is my responsibility to have properly sewn, ready to wear pointe shoes for all pre-pro ballet co and ballet co rehearsal/class time. For my own safety I will not continue to wear 'dead' shoes, and I will have new shoes sewn and properly broken in in time for the start of class each week.

_____ I understand in order to maintain and acquire professional-grade costuming a portion of the ballet company fees are applied to purchasing, cleaning, fitting, managing, and storage of costumes. Per the director's discretion, some costumes may be kept by the studio in order to maintain a viable inventory. Current company members benefit from past costuming, and their contribution applies to current and future performances.

_____ I understand some select items will need to be purchased on an as needed basis at my own expense. These items include, but are not limited to: stage make-up and accessories (false lashes, etc), nude briefs for coverage under white romantic tutu, etc.

____ I am aware nude color leotards are not to be worn under the white bodices and white romantic skirts worn in pre-pro ballet co and ballet co performances. The white bodices provide ample coverage and the purchase of nude briefs for under the white romantic skirt allow for additional coverage as well.

_____ I understand the following pre-pro ballet co and ballet co class attire is permitted and appropriate: black or colored leotard, pink ballet tights fully covering the entire foot, pointe shoes and hair securely pulled back in a bun/french twist, etc. Short ballet skirts are permitted. I also understand that the ability to wear a colored leotard is a privilege, and will continue to dress for pre pro ballet co and ballet co rehearsals with professionalism out of respect for my teachers, myself, and the reputation of pre pro ballet co and ballet co

Girth is the measurement beginning at the top of the shoulder (near the neck), down the front through the crotch, up the back to where you started at the shoulder. If you are not comfortable with this, ask the office staff to assist you.
