

## <u>City of Ketchum Parks & Recreation Programming Rules and Personal</u> <u>Responsibility Guidelines</u>

While inside the Recreation Center we will maintain a clean, safe, interactive and fun facility by not allowing the following:

- Disruptive behavior (interruptions/disturbances)
- Excessive noise/shouting/screaming
- Uncooperative behavior (not listening to directions/ not participating)
- Running or rough- housing
- Misuse of games, art supplies, telephone, furnishings, etc.
- Chewing gum
- No ipads (or similar electronic devices) allowed during our after school program
- Parents may be charged extra if picking their children up late becomes an issue

While anywhere in the Park we will show respect for the rights and safety of ourselves and others by not allowing the following:

- Unsafe game activity (wrestling, tackling, not following rules, etc.)
- Physical violence, fighting
- Throwing snowballs, ice, rocks, wood chips, pinecones, or any object that will cause harm
- Bad verbal or body language, verbal or physical harassment (name calling, teasing, pushing or shoving)
- Leaving Park boundaries without permission of parent and Park staff
- Guns, knives, or devices that can cause harm
- No ipads (or similar electronic devices) allowed during our after school program
- There will be no climbing trees, fences or on the outside of the slides

At all times we will show respect for public and personal property by not allowing the following:

- Taking, touching, or damaging other people's belongings; stealing
- Causing damage to Park or school property
- Littering/leaving trash

We will respect decisions and directions from the coaches and adult park staff by not allowing the following:

- Defiance toward others (disobedience)
- Speaking or acting disrespectfully
- Arguing with staff or running away when asked to be spoken to
