

Pendleton Youth Basketball (PYB) Coaching Application

Frequently Asked Questions:

How are teams organized?

The 3rd/4th grade boys division and the 5th/6th grade boys divisions are composed of 8-10 players per team. The 1st/2nd grade boys and girls teams will have a similar number of players per coach. These ratios are dependent on getting enough volunteer coaches.

What is the time commitment?

The *BOYS 3rd-6th* season begins with our coach's clinic/skills assessment date on Saturday, October 22, 2016 and ends just prior to the Christmas holiday. Practices are typically two days per week in area elementary schools. Games are played at Sunridge Middle School on Saturdays.

GIRLS 3rd-6th season begins with coach's clinic/skills assessment date on Saturday, January 7, 2017 and ends February 25, 2017.

The 1st/2nd grade *BOYS & GIRLS* begin Saturday, January 14, 2017. The 1st/2nd grade program is based around skill development and will occur on Saturdays with unofficial competition/scrimmage opportunities at the end of practice.

Do I need to have any previous experience?

It helps but is not necessarily a requirement. Through the coach's clinic you will learn some helpful drills and techniques to advance your players skills. Each coach will also be given a coaching youth basketball book that is very helpful for coaching at this level.

Will my child get free registration?

Yes, after coaching status is confirmed.
