

**When and where can I pick up my race packet?**

Race packets may be picked up Friday, March 27, from 4-6pm at the Gilruth Center and on race day at the check-in tent.

**What is the schedule the day of the race?**

7:00am-Check-in starts

7:45am – Best Dressed Vote!

7:50am – Group Stretch

7:55am – National Anthem

8am- Kid's 1k

8:15am – 5k Race Launch

9:15am – 5k individual and team winner's awards presentation (pavilion)

**If I am a NASA badged employee, do I need to wear it? What if I am not a NASA badged employee?**

For security purposes, all participants will be given a wristband to wear on race day. Everyone must go to the check-in tent the morning of the race to receive a band. They will not be given on Friday with packet pickup. You do not have to be a NASA badged employee to participate.

**Are kids allowed?**

**What time does the race begin?**

The 1k begins at 8am. The 5k begins at 8:15am. Check-in starts at 7:00am at the Gilruth Center west parking lot.

**Can I Walk?**

Walking is totally acceptable! We want everyone to experience the thrill of the Aliens vs Astronauts 1k & 5k. The race is fun, so you will not feel pressure.

**How do I volunteer?**

**What do I get for registering?**

Race packets include t-shirt, race bib, chip tracker, and a finisher medal.

**Will I be timed?**

Yes, but this event is both competitive and non-competitive, so you will not feel pressure. Although, if you want to push yourself, you can.

**How can I win an award?**

Trophies will be given out to the following 5k participants only:

- Top 3 overall men and women finishers in the categories below.
- 20 and under, 21-30, 31-40, 41-50, 51-60 and 61+
- 40-minute time limit for 5k to be eligible.
- Top 3 teams (3 persons) who have the lowest combined times will receive a team trophy. Combined time limit of 120 minutes per team are eligible.
- Best-Dressed Award. Dress like an Alien or Astronaut. The people's applause will determine a winner.
