- **PAPER - To Print out your packets & for practicing.**

- Smooth printer paper

Any smooth printer paper will be awesome. When printing out the printable packet that includes guide sheets at a print shop, ask for the “premium paper”, it’s usually a 28 or 32# text paper that’s smooth like butter. (I use HP Premium choice laserjet paper, ream of 500, #113100)

- **BRUSH PEN: This is the ONLY pen you will be using for lettering in this class. Please make sure you get this particular pen, as this hard tip is best for control and learning.**

- **CRAYOLA broad line markers for your project(s)
(AVOID CHISEL TIP!)**

- **PLASTIC ROUND LID (oval shape), or plate about 4 inches in diameter.
(as a guide for lowercase project)**

- **SHARPIE - Black fine tip marker**

- **Optional (to do your projects)**

- Fine tip colored markers (any brand is fine)

- Different colored gel pens (any brand is fine)
